(Constituted by BCA)
Report-1, Meeting -2 **Date: 09.08.2020**

The pre-scheduled meeting of Affiliation Review Committee (BCA) of the three members was held on 09 August 2020 at Patna Palace, Fraser Road, Patna from 11 AM. The names and designations of the committee members involved in the meeting are as follows:

1. Mr. Saurav Chakraborty – Chairman
2. Mr. Pradeep Kumar Singh- Convener
3. Mr. Sanjay Kumar Mannu- Legal Head

The proceedings of the meeting began on the direction of the Chairman of the Committee. All the members gave their views after studying the constitution in force in the BCA on the basis of the forms submitted by the 20 districts and the documents provided by the BCA relating to the said districts, the Lokpal and the electoral officer's decision and the recommendations of the Lodha Committee. The 20 districts which are being decided in today's decision have been placed in three categories. The first one which is in the category of fully qualified, the second where all members are not disqualified, and the third is where all members are ineligible.

After discussing on several points, the members unanimously decided according to the category and as per Lodha committee recommendations of districts that:-

Report:

As per record President, Secretary, Joint Secretary and Treasurer, they all the four members of Munger DCA are disqualified, because all are associated more than 9 years. It is violation of Rules and Regulations of BCA. As our opinion BCA shall take suitable action against the all four disqualified officials, and instruct to Vice President of the Munger DCA to frame the new committee as per by laws and informed the BCA as soon as possible.

Report:

The papers of the Begusarai DCA submitted by Bihar Cricket Association to the Review Committee were carefully scrutinized and it was found that the whole committee of the Begusarai DCA are disqualified as per Lodha committee recommendation. They violated the Rules & Regulations of Bihar Cricket Association, It's a very serious allegation. As per our opinion that the Begusarai DCA must be terminated and a new committee should formed in the light of Lodha Committee Recommendations. As per Rules and regulations 5(A)(B) of BCA we also recommend for legal action for recovering of amount, which is paid by BCA. We also recommend

taking suitable/ appropriate legal action against officials of Begusarai DCA for forgery as per Rules.

As elections have already been announced in two districts units, namely **Arwal** and **Bhojpur**, and their electoral process will commence shortly, therefore these two districts will be reviewed on the basis of documents provided to BCA after the completion of their respective elections, and also on documents already available with BCA.

The remaining 16 districts are still under review. These districts will continue to have an earlier position till their review report is completed. Moreover, as various cases/complaints of several district units are pending with the Ombudsman of BCA and/or in court(s), we are of the opinion that it will be the statutory responsibility of the District Associations and BCA to honor their subsequent orders/decisions.
